COURSE FEES

R4,750 per module = R38,000 Plus registration fee

COURSE INFORMATION

The Advanced Diploma in Labour Law (ADLL) is aimed at working professionals in the field of labour law. This qualification is on a learning pathway that underpins a career in the Labour Relations arena.

The programme is aimed at equipping students with knowledge competencies in mastering, analysing and interpreting specialised rules and principles of labour law.

A large number of the competencies developed in the qualification, are rooted in actual workplace practice and should lead to greater productivity resulting from the improved performance by the student through the integration of knowledge and workplace practice in its social and legal context.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection criteria is based on applicants meeting the minimum requirements, subject to capping target numbers of students on the programme particularly in the first five years of the programme. The most suitable applicants, in terms of previous academic performance and relevant work experience, will be considered.

ARTICULATION

Upon completion of the programme the student may apply for the Postgraduate Diploma in Labour Law, subject to selection from the relevant department.

The 8 module programme will run from February to November
