ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ An appropriate Diploma at NQF6 or;
- ❖ A qualification that is of an equivalent standard;
- ❖ Minimum of 3 years' work experience in the relevant field.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Desktop or laptop with data and a stable internet connection.
- ❖ Required documents: ID, updated CV, relevant diplomas.

EXIT LEVEL / OUTCOMES

- ❖ NQF7 level Advanced Diploma from the University of the Western Cape, Faculty of Law.
